A Duet for Two Readers

1 – As long as the earth endures, seedtime and harvest, cold and heat, summer and winter, day and night will never cease. (\*a)

1 & 2 – There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under heaven:

1 – a time to be born and a time to die,

2 – a time to plant and a time to uproot,

1 – a time to kill and a time to heal,

2 – a time to tear down and a time to build,

1 – a time to weep and a time to laugh.

2 – Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts. (\*b) I tell you, now is a time of God's favor, now is the day of salvation. (\*c)

1 – There is a time for everything –

2 – a time to mourn and a time to dance,

1 – a time to scatter stones and a time to gather them,

2 – a time to embrace and a time to refrain,

1 – a time to search and a time to give up,

2 – a time to keep and a time to throw away.

1 – Whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him. (\*d)

2 – There is a season for every activity under heaven –

1 – a time to tear and a time to mend,

2 – a time to be silent and a time to speak,

1 – a time to love and a time to hate,

2 – a time for war and a time for peace.
